Temporary Relief from Zoning Code Sign Requirements COVID-19 Recovery

The City of Oxford has relaxed temporary sign regulations in **non-residential zoning districts** in order to assist the private sector in economic recovery and security.

Examples of temporary signs are banners, flags, for sale/rent and construction.

All signs shall still be maintained and monitored by the business owner or operator to avoid blowing away, washing into storm drains, or otherwise resulting in environmental degradation.

The Community Development Director, Chief of Police and City Manager will retain authority to administer sign regulations as deemed necessary in the spirit of the public health, safety and welfare, further outlined in Oxford Code Section 1151.01.
